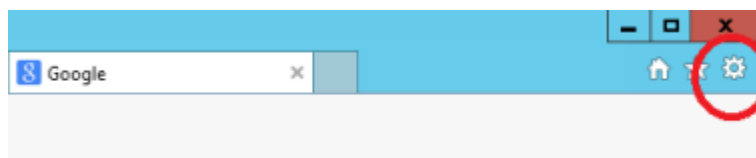

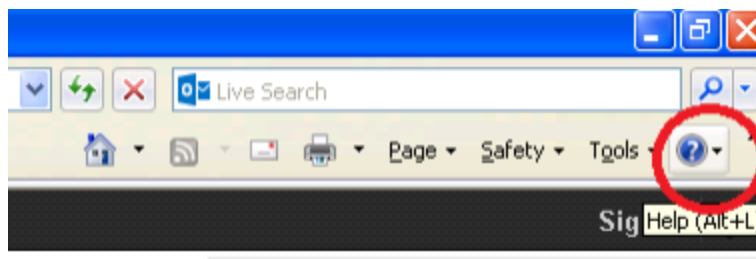
Internet Explorer

Either the 'Tool' Icon or the 'Help' icon on the top right and select 'About Internet Explorer' from the drop down menu.

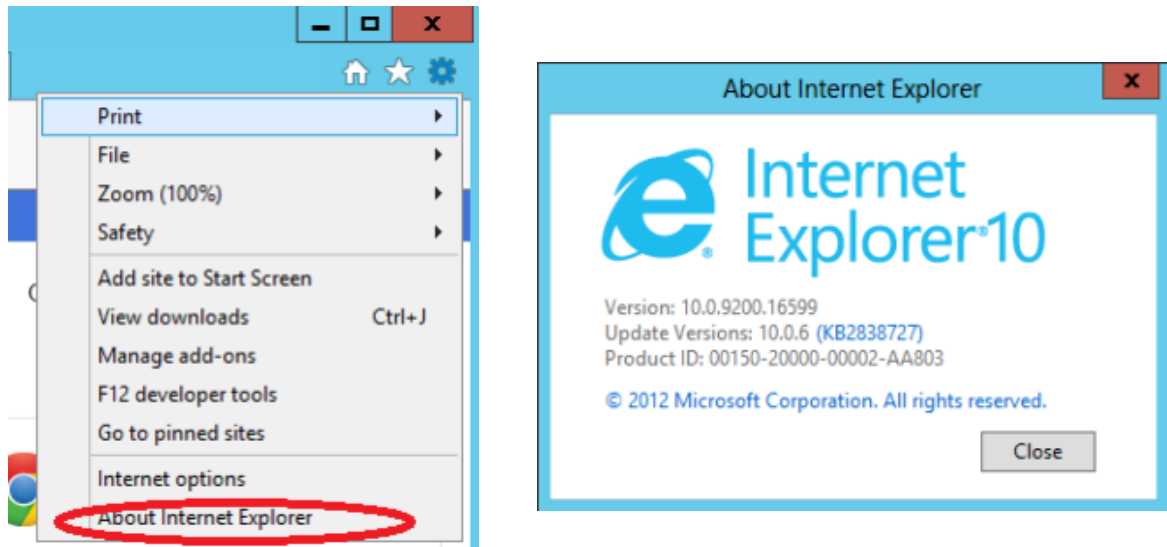
Tool Icon (IE 10, 11):



Help Icon (Earlier IE versions):

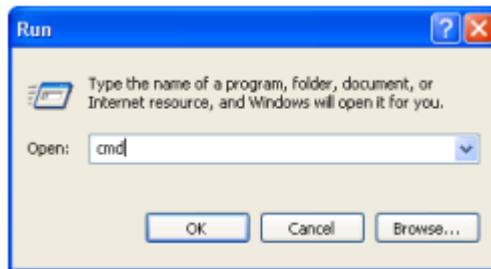

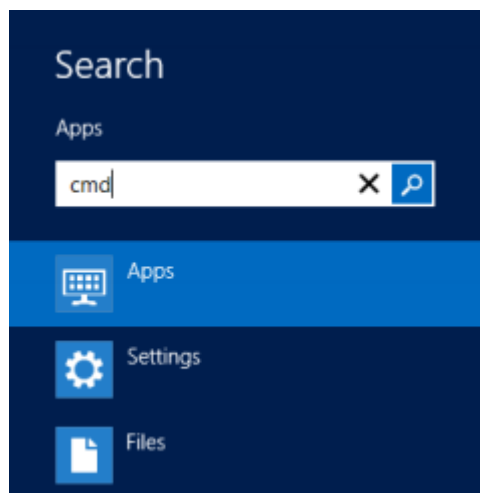


To run a command window please click start -> run -> type cmd (earlier versions):
